

HORSE FLY SPRAY is especially designed to protect Horses and Ponies from stable flies, horn flies, horse flies, deer flies, face flies, house flies, mosquitoes and gnats.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Remove protective cap. Hold container in an upright position with valve opening pointing toward animal to be treated. Press valve button to spray.

FOR BITING FLIES (STABLE FLIES, HORN FLIES, HORSE FLIES, DEER FLIES) HOUSE FLIES, MOSQUITOES AND GNATS

Apply HORSE FLY SPRAY so as to lightly dampen animal's hair. Spray animal thoroughly including legs and under belly. Repeat spray daily as needed.

FOR FACE FLIES

To protect animal's face from face flies, spray animal's head and neck, using just enough spray to slightly dampen the tops of hair. Repeat as needed.

HORSE FLY SPRAY container should be held 12 to 18 inches from animal when spraying. Do not apply in excess of 2 ounces of spray per animal per day (about 1 1/2 minutes of spraying time).

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing of spray mist or contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. In case of contact with skin and eyes, flush with plenty of water; for eyes, get medical attention. Do not contaminate feed, water or feed stuffs. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Do not treat animals under 6 months of age. Note to Physician: Atropine is antidotal.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

CAUTION

Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, feed or feed by storage or disposal.

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in newspaper and place in trash collection.

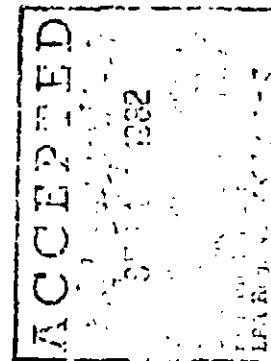
STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
