Dear Mr. Santerre:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the following changes to your label:

a) In the DIRECTIONS FOR USE, add the words indicated in italics to the end of the following sentence:

"Apply as a dip or sponge onto the animal's coat, *avoiding pet's eyes, nose and mouth.*"

2. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Keep out of reach of children. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals or animals on medication. Sensitivities may occur after using **ANY** pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes plus socks and household latex or rubber gloves when applying this product. ■ Change clothing as soon as possible after use. ■ Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As with any pesticide product, wash hands thoroughly immediately after handling and before eating, smoking or using the toilet.

Statement of Practical Treatment/ First Aid

IF SWALLOWED: Induce vomiting with finger to back of throat. Call a physician.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. If irritation persists, see physician.

Do not use this product on animals simultaneously or within 30 days before or after treatment with or exposure to cholinesterase inhibiting drugs, pesticides or chemicals. However, flea and tick collars may be immediately replaced.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN and VETERINARIAN: Carbaryl is a moderate reversible cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine Sulfate is antidotal.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use product only outside or in a well-ventilated area. Wearing household latex or rubber gloves, mix the contents of this packet with one gallon of water. Mix thoroughly to insure uniform suspension. Apply as a dip or sponge onto the animal's coat. Thoroughly wet animal's coat.

For Sponge treatment: One packet and one gallon of water will treat most animals.

For Dipping: Small Dogs - 2 packets and 2 gallons of water.
 Medium Dogs - 5 packets and 5 gallons of water.
 Large Dogs - 20 packets and 20 gallons of water.

This product should not be applied by children. Do not use on pregnant dogs. Do not use on puppies under 12 weeks of age. Repeat treatment as required but not more than once weekly.

Note: A light color residue may sometimes be seen on dark colored animals. Should this be objectionable, it may be removed by brushing the animal lightly after the coat is dry.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in original container in cool, locked storage area.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty packet. Discard empty packet in trash.
