

Statement of Practical Treatment

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. If irritation persist, see a physician.

Do not use this product on animals simultaneously or within 30 days before or after treatment with or exposure to cholinesterase inhibiting drugs, pesticides or chemicals. However, flea and tick collars may be immediately replaced.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN and VETERINARIAN: Carbaryl is a moderate reversible cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine sulfate is antidotal.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

HOW TO USE: For control of <u>fleas</u>, <u>ticks</u> and <u>lice</u> - Use product only outside or in a well-ventilated area. Wearing household latex or rubber gloves, dust pet liberally by rubbing dust into animals hair. Begin at tail and work toward the head. Take care not to get dust in animals eyes, nose or mouth. Be sure to dust paws and between toes. This product should not be applied by children. Do not use on pregnant dogs. Repeat as needed, but not more often than crice weekly.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in original container in cool, locked storage area.

Disposal: Do not reuse container. Empty completely, wrap in newspaper before discarding

in trash.
