CAUTION

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENTS

- If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
- If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.
- If on skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
- If in eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR FLEA AND TICK CONTROL: Apply dust to the dog's coat, paying attention to treat the entire animal, including the legs and feet. Work dust into the hair working from the tail to the head. Keep out of dog's eyes and mouth. Use about 1/4 teaspoon (0.5 gms) of dust per pound of body weight. One treatment will control ticks for about 14 days, and fleas for up to three weeks. Wearing gloves during application is advisable.

FOR CONTROL OF SARCOPTIC MANGE: Treat dog's hair coat as described above weekly for three weeks. Treat infected areas thoroughly. If no improvement is observed in three weeks, consult your Veterinarian.

DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not reuse container. Dispose of container in trash collection.
