

Remove cap and press down button with hole away from you. Hold container approximately 6 inches from animal. Work from rear of animal towards the head, fluffing the hair to permit the spray to penetrate to the skin. Spray only enough to slightly dampen the hair and skin. Wet ticks with the spray. Do not get spray in eyes or on scrotum.

Use spray on the basis of 4 to 6 seconds for a 5 pound cat and 20 to 30 seconds for a 25 pound dog. Repeat treatment if necessary; but not more than once a week. (The hissing sound and the cool sensation caused by the spray may temporarily frighten nervous pets; however, they are expected to become accustomed to the treatment.) Treat bedding, interior of kennels and other places where ticks and fleas congregate to help prevent reinfestation.
