Wipe-on: Use a soft towel or sponge to apply. Clean animal's coat of dust and debris before application. Moisten applicator and rub first against the hair and then with the hair, to smooth coat and give sheen. Be sure to treat animal thoroughly in order that maximum repellency is obtained. Good coverage is important. Repeat as needed.

Spray-on: Add Fly Repellent to suitable spray device or bottle. Apply a light mist on hair using 2 ounces per animal. Do not wet hair to skin. Apply carefully on legs and belly. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool place. Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse this container. Dispose in trash collection.
