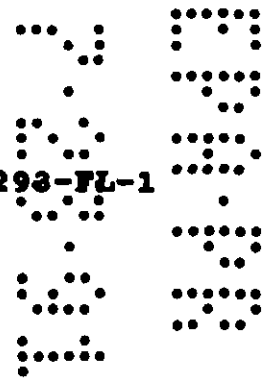

To control spinose ear ticks and ear mites in the ears of dogs and cats, dilute this solution with water at the rate of 1 ounce to 18 ounces of water. Syringe the ear with a few drops of this solution so that it penetrates the wax down to the surrounding tissue. Repeat treatment once or twice at 2 or 3 day intervals as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in original container, in a cool, dry, locked storage area.

Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.
