Dip or Sponge Bath: To control ticks, fleas and lice on cats and dogs, dilute this concentrate at the rate of 1 fluid ounce to 23 fluid ounces of water (5 ounces per gallon of water) and mix well to form a creamy emulsion dip.

Dip or sponge the animal with this solution being careful to thoroughly wet the entire animal. Do not enter a low solution to which an animal.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse this container. Wrap container in newspaper and put in trash collection.
