PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

WARNING: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Wash hands with soap and water after using and before eating or smoking. Do not use in dairy barns or poultry houses. - If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.
- If On Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
- If In Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention immediately.

DIP OR SPONGE BATH: Mix 8 ounces of UNICORN Lindane Dog Dip with 15 gallons of water and stir to form a creamy emulsion. For control of Fleas and Ticks, dip dogs thoroughly or sponge dip solution on to animal. One treatment will kill fleas and ticks. For Mange, dip dogs thoroughly with two applications one week apart.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not reuse this container. Wrap empty container and put in trash collection.
