PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

WARNING: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Wash hands with soap and water after using and before eating or smoking. Do not use in dairy barns or poultry houses. Do not treat nursing females or pups under 4 months of age. Do not use on cats or livestock other than dogs. Avoid contamination of feed stuffs.

Use of this product is permitted only for treatment of mites. The use of this product for treatment of other pest is prohibited. Applicators must wear the following protective clothing during treatment process: elbow length, water-proof gloves; a waterproof apron; and unlined, water proof boots. Improper dilution of this product could cause serious injury to your pet. Children should not be allowed to handle or apply this product.

Observe dog after dipping. If reaction occurs, wash dog thoroughly with soap and water, discontinue use and consult a veterinarian. Oil slick spots or film on top of dip solution indicates break in emulsion and danger to dogs. When such is evident, discard and mix new dip. If dip is not milky smooth, do not use.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

- IF SWALLOWED: Call a Physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING: Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.
- IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.
- IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
- IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention immediately.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or by disposal of dip solution.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DIP OR SPONGE BATH: Mix 8 ounces of UNICORN Lindane Dog Dip with 15 gallons of water and stir to form a creamy emulsion. For control of Saropitic Mange, dip dogs thoroughly with two applications two weeks apart.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not reuse this container. Wrap empty container and put in trash collection.

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Scabies is caused by Sarcoptes scabiei, Psoroptic Mange is caused by the scab mites Psoroptidae, and there is no such disease as Saropitic Mange. Revise your front panel label claims as follows:

"Controls Sarcoptic Mange (Scabies mites) and Psoroptic Mange (Scab Mites)"

2. Revise the directions accordingly.
3. In paragraph one of the "HAZARDS TO HUMANS..." section delete: "Do not use in dairy barns or poultry houses." as this suggests misuse.
4. Page 2, paragraph 2, line 2 of the draft labeling: change "pest" to the plural "pests".

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

If you hold a Federal registration, a supplemental registration, or a Special Local Needs registration, you may continue to produce new stocks of such products, using current labeling, until May 31, 1984. After that date, all remaining inventories of affected products will fall under the Existing Stocks provisions stated in our letter of October 28, 1983.
