HAZARDS TO HUMAN AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. May cause allergic skin reaction. Wear gloves when using this product to bathe dogs. Do not treat sick or debilitated animals or animals under 4 months of age. Do not treat nursing animals.

NOT TO PHYSICIAN: Atropine Sulfate by injection is antidotal only if signs of cholinesterase inhibition are present.

This product is toxic to fish, birds and wildlife. Do not apply directly to lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning or disposal of wastes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

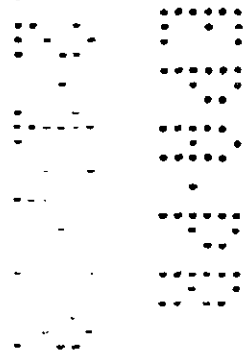
For use on Dogs, to kill Fleas, Ticks and Sarcoptic Mange Mites, dilute two ounces of Dog Dip to 1 gallons of water (8 oz. to 4 gallons) and mix well. Dip or sponge animals until the hair coat is thoroughly wet to the skin. Do not rinse. Allow solution to dry on animals. Do not repeat treatment more often than once every 4 weeks. Do not use this product on animals which have been treated with cholinesterase inhibiting materials within the past 30 days.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not reuse container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

- e. In your Directions for Use section revise the sentence, "Do not use this product on animals which have been treated..." to read "Do not use this product on animals simultaneously or within 30 days before or after treatment with or exposure to cholinesterase inhibiting drugs, pesticides or chemicals." Add the following statement to your use directions:

Do not use on cats.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
