f. Correct spelling of butylcarbityl in ingredient statement footnote.

g. Revise the statement:

If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING.
Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

h. Add Note to Physician to read: Solvents present aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be used in conjunction with atropine.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation, eye, skin and clothing contact. Wash thoroughly after using.

Do not contaminate feed, water or foodstuffs. Food should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using Fogger in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation. Remove pets and cover fish tanks or fish bowls before using.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

- If Swallowed: Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
- If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply respiration if indicated.
- If on Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
- If in Eyes: Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water. Call a physician immediately.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use one canister for each 10,000 cu. ft. of unobstructed area.

PREPARATION: Open cabinets and doors to areas to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all open flames except pilot light. Remove pets and cover fish tanks or fish bowls with paper or remove from area. Close exterior doors and windows. Cover exposed foods, dishes, and food handling equipment.

TO START FOGGING: Place Fogger on table, chair or stand, at least six feet from pilot light. Place several thicknesses of newspapers under canister to prevent marring of surface. Hold can at arm's length, with top of can pointing away from face and eyes. Push down on finger pad until it locks - this will start fogging action. Set canister in upright position on table, etc., and leave building at once. DO NOT RE-ENTER BUILDING FOR TWO HOURS, then open exterior doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes before reoccupying area.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in cool, dry area away from heat and open flame. Do not re-use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
