The revised labeling referenced to above, submitted in connection with the registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) as amended, is acceptable, provided you incorporate the Agency's conditions as enumerated in this letter and submit one copy of your final printed label prior to releasing the product for shipment.

The registration record for the product named above has been amended to change the product name to:


Unicorn Food Processing Plant Spray.

The Agency acknowledges that because the product is packaged in a 15 gallon container, it does not need to be classified as a restricted use pesticide. Per the MOA, for liquid products packaged in containers smaller than 15 gallons the label must contain the restricted use text.

Submit one copy of the revised final printed label before releasing the product for shipment. If the conditions enumerated above are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA Section 6(e).

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Keep away from food, feedstuffs, and domestic water supplies. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried. Do not spray air in rooms or use on plants. Apply as a surface spray only as specified on this label. Thoroughly wash dishes and food handling utensils if contaminated with this product.

Environmental Hazards

This product is toxic to fish. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

Physical or Chemical Hazards

Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame.

Statement of Practical Treatment

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician immediately. If gastric lavage is deemed necessary, undertake if material was taken internally. Do not induce vomiting unless no other treatment is available. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If necessary to induce vomiting, give 1 or 2 glasses water and insert finger in back of throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air and apply respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN: Wash promptly with soap and water. Rinse thoroughly.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. If irritation persist, get medical attention.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Contains a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine Sulfate is antidotal.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with labeling.

For use in garbage rooms, floor drains (to sewers), machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling) of food processing plants. Apply as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to baseboard areas, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, pallets and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter. Repeat treatment as required.

COCKROACHES, ANTS, EARWIGS, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS AND CRICKETS:

Apply small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using equipment capable of delivering a pin stream of insecticide, in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases, in conduits, motor housing, junction or switch boxes. Prior to application de-energize electrical equipment. After

application allow time for oil to evaporate before starting motors or placing switches in "ON" position. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

FOOD AREAS - APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY:

Including areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing) preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups).

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container away from heat or open flame, in locked storage area.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly, wrap in newspaper before discarding in trash.
