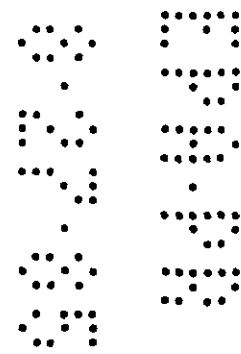

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Remove protective cap, and spray from a distance of 8-12 inches from surface to be protected. Slightly moisten surface-saturation is not necessary. Use slow sweeping motion.

FOR EXPOSED SKIN AREAS, to repel flies, gnats and mosquitoes: Use as directed above. AVOID CONTACT WITH EYES OR MOUTH. For treating face, spray in palm of hand, rub palms together and rub on face.

FOR CLOTHING, to repel ticks, fleas and chiggers (See CAUTION) --- Make liberal application along all openings of the clothing, such as inside the neck band, the fly and cuffs of trousers, tops of socks, eyelets of shoes and areas of clothing which may contact the ground, weeds or other growth.

DISPOSAL

Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
