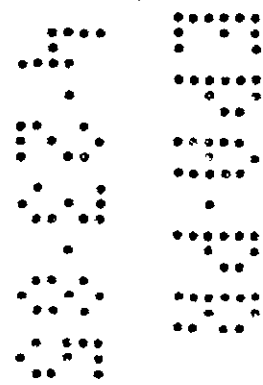

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

OUTDOORS: Application should be made late in the evening when insects are at rest. Point spout toward nest, crevice or hole where insects are known to exist. Hold container at arms length and spray liberally into hiding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary. Always spray in direction of wind (with wind at your back).

INDOORS: Aim spray directly at nests. Do not spray areas where food and foodstuffs are exposed or handled. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the areas after treatment is completed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame. Disposal: Do not reuse empt container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
