## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

### Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with the eyes, skin or clothing. In case of contact, immediately wash with soap and water. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuff.

### Chemical Hazards

### Statement of Practical Treatment

**INDOORS:** Aim spray directly at nests. Do not spray areas where food and foodstuffs are exposed or handled. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the areas after treatment is completed.
