OUTDOORS: Application should be made late in the evening when insects are at rest. Point spout toward nest, crevice or hole where insects are known to exist. Hold container at arms length and spray liberally into hiding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary. Always spray in direction of wind (with wind at your back).

<u>INDOORS:</u> Aim spray directly at nests. Do not spray areas where food and foodstuffs are exposed or handled. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the areas, after treatment is completed.

Do not spray areas where food and foodstuffs are exposed or handled except as directed under use in USDA Establishments.

FOR USE IN ALL AREAS OF USDA ESTABLISHMENTS: Before using this pesticide compound, exposed food products and packaging materials must be removed from the room or protected. After using this compound, equipment and utensils must be washed with an effective cleaning compound and thoroughly rinsed with potable water before operations are resumed.
