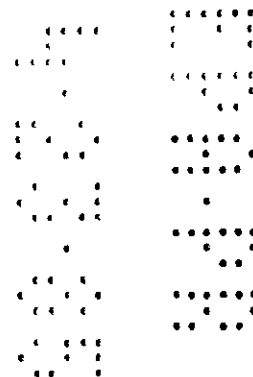

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching finger down throat.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is extremely toxic to aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

DIRECTION FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

How to Use: For best results to kill Fleas, Ticks and Lice on Dogs and Cats, dust powder liberally over the entire body. Rub dust into hair with special care to the feet, pads and between the toes are treated well. Take care not to get the powder in animals eyes, nose or mouth. Dust bedding and kennel and sleeping area regularly. Repeat as needed, but not more often than once weekly.

DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in newspaper and put in trash collection.
