PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: May be harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing of dust when you apply powder. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not use on pregnant dogs. Do not use on nursing kittens or puppies. Do not use on kittens or puppies under 4 weeks of age.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Carbaryl is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal.

Statement of Practical Treatment

IF SWALLOWED: Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching finger down throat.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water.

Environmental Hazards

This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates. Drift and runoff may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes and potholes). Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

HOW TO USE: For best results to kill Fleas, Ticks and Lice on Dogs and Cats, dust powder liberally over the entire body. Rub dust into hair with special care to the feet, pads and between the toes are treated well. Take care not to get the powder in animals eyes, nose or mouth. Dust bedding and kennel and sleeping area regularly. Repeat as needed, but not more often than once weekly.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in original container in a cool, locked storage area away from heat and open flame.

Disposal: Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash
