

d. Revise your Storage and Disposal directions to include a statement such as "Store in a cool dry place preferably in a locked storage area."

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

1. The front panel of the label must bear the following:

2. Revise your existing precautionary statements beginning, "Caution: Avoid prolonged breathing xxx etc"., to read

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:
 CAUTION: Avoid breathing of smoke. Avoid contact with skin and eyes.
