- Large Dogs - 20 packets and 20 gallons of water.

Repeat treatment as required but not more than once weekly.

Note: A light color residue may sometimes be seen on dark colored animals. Should this be objectionable, it may be removed by brushing the animal lightly after the coat is dry.

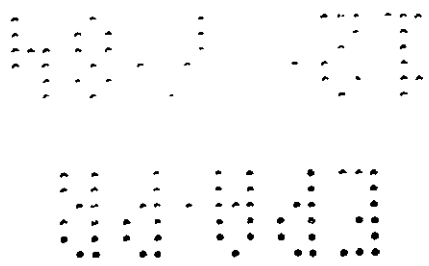
