

DOGS AND CATS: Direct the spray over the animal until the entire coat is slightly damp. On a heavily coated animal, ruffle the coat and spray against the lay of the hair. For best results in controlling ticks, spray directly on the tick. Thoroughly spray interior of kennel or other sleeping quarters. Repeat treatment as necessary. Do not spray structural surfaces where spotting, staining, or discoloration may be objectionable.

KITTENS AND PUPPIES. Treat same as dogs and cats, except for nursing kittens and puppies. Wrap the animal in a towel which has been sprayed lightly. Leave the nose and mouth exposed for normal breathing. Keep the animal wrapped for 5 to 10 minutes. Fleas may then be removed from the coat by picking or combing. Repeat as necessary.

FOR HORSES AND PONIES: Remove excess dirt and dust by brushing coat. Apply spray directly to horse's coat giving particular attention to legs, shoulders, flanks, neck, and topline. To treat face, dampen a cloth with spray and rub on face and head, being careful to avoid eyes, Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in oliginal container away from heat or open flame. Downst reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
