<u>Cats and Dogs:</u> Cover animals eyes with hand and with a firm fast stroke, to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears, and chest until damp. With finger tips rub into face around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hind quarters, finishing legs last. For best penetration of spray to the skin, diffect spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long haired dogs, rub your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets tieks. Repeat treatment as needed.

Puppies and Kittens: Treat same as cats and dogs except nursing puppies and kittens, spray only along back or on your finger tips and rub in with your finger tips.

<u>Pet Sleeping Quarters:</u> Spray around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and local area of floors. If mosquitoes, gnats or flies are present, spray lightly into the air. Repeat as needed. The bedding should be sprayed and then replaced with fresh, clean bedding for best results.

<u>Horses:</u> To control stable flies, horse flies, deer flies and face flies, apply to face, legs, flanks, topline and other body areas commonly affected by these pests. Repeat treatment as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in original container away from heat or open flame, in locked storage area.

Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.

For containers 1 gallon and over: Triple rinse (or equivalent), then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
