On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby Registered/Reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act.

A copy of the labeling accepted in connection with this Registration/Reregistration is returned herewith.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an indorsement or approval of this product by this Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

The product is hereby registered/re-registered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act. The following conditions must be met:

1. Submit to all data on the water solubility of the concentrate and dip. The Agency requires all registrants of such products to submit this data.

2. Have the labeling changes listed below before you re-label for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 28293-146."
- b. The signal word "Caution" must appear on the front panel.
- c. Change the statement "Do not contaminate any body of water with this concentrate or dip or by cleaning of equipment" to read "Do not contaminate any body of water with this concentrate or dip or when disposing of equipment washwater."
- d. Since the product appears to be essentially for domestic use, the Storage and Disposal statement should be revised to read:

"Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal."

f. Add a Statement of Practical Treatment to read:

"Statement of Practical Treatment

If Swallowed: Do not induce vomiting. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately."

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

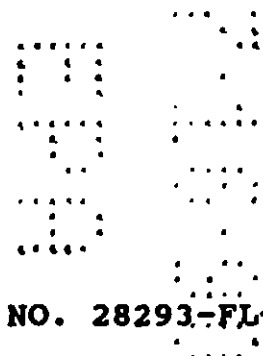

To kill Fleas, Lice and Ticks: Bathe pet with a quality shampoo. Dilute 4 ounces of Unicorn Concentrated Flea & Tick Dip with 1 gallon of water. Dip animal into solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin. The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal. Do not rinse off. Repeat as necessary for control.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal:

- (a) For containers 1 gallon and over. Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
