
Dear Mr. Santerre:

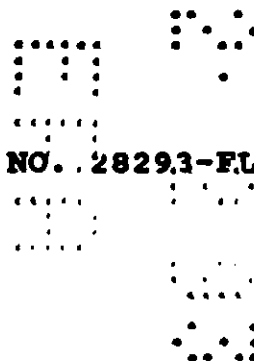

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Do not contaminate food or feedstuffs with this concentrate or dip.

Environmental Hazards

This product is toxic to fish and other aquatic animals. Do not contaminate any body of water with this concentrate or dip or when disposing of equipment washwaters.

Physical Hazards

Do not store or use near heat or open flame.

Statement of Practical Treatment

IF SWALLOWED: Do not induce vomiting. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To Kill Fleas, Lice and Ticks: Bathe pet with a quality shampoo. Dilute 4 ounces of Unicorn Concentrated Flea & Tick Dip with 1 gallon of water. Dip Animal into solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin. The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal. Do not rinse off. Repeat as necessary for control.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.
