How does the user know how much to apply (i.e. brush)? Do hair and pet body debris affect the distribution of the liquid over time? 3. Submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

Use protective gloves (mitts) to prevent contact with hands. Spray the animal from a distance of 8-12 inches. Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure the animal's entire body is covered, including the legs and under the body. Fluff the hair as you spray, so the spray will penetrate to the skin. The spray should wet the ticks thoroughly. Do not spray in face, eyes or on genitalia. Repeat as needed.

For cats apply at a rate of 1 second per pound of body weight. For dogs apply at the rate of 2 seconds per pound of body weight for thin or shorthaired dogs and up to 8 seconds per pound of body weight for heavy or longhaired dogs.
