PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Statement of Practical Treatment

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO KILL FLEAS, LICE AND TICKS: Dilute 2 ounces of concentrate with 1 gallon of water. Dip animal into solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin. The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal. Dipping should not exceed 30 seconds. Do not rinse. This product should not be used on animals more than once every seven days. Kills fleas and ticks up to 21 days.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in a locked storage area in original container.

Disposal: Do not reuse bottle. Wrap bottle in newspaper and discard in trash.
