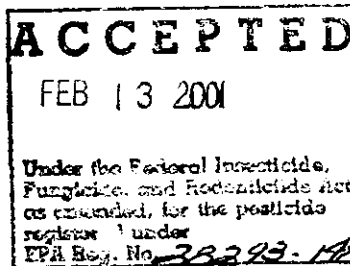

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product must be diluted before use.

TO KILL FLEAS, LICE, TICKS AND MANGE MITES: Dilute 2 ounces (4 tablespoons) of concentrate with 1 gallon of water. Dip animal into solution or sponge on solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin. The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal. Dipping should not exceed 30 seconds. Do not reapply product for seven days. Kills fleas and ticks up to 21 days. Do not use on puppies or kittens under twelve (12) weeks of age.

Gives long lasting residual control and repellency for fleas and ticks on dogs and cats.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in a locked storage area in original container.

Disposal: Do not reuse bottle. Wrap bottle in newspaper and discard in trash.
