Unicorn Knockdown Spray
EPA Registration No. 28293-158
Your Submission dated November 7, 1991

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. Add "feed" to the food establishment paragraph i.e.,
-----do not use in food/feed areas -----
-----food/feed handling-----
-----where food/feed is commercially-----
2. The label bears the site "schools" therefore, add the following precaution:
Do not apply when classrooms are in use.

Although we do not object to the subject amendment, please be aware that the Agency is currently soliciting information and comments on revised precautionary language, testing and information on static electricity generation, all in connection with aerosol products containing extremely flammable propellents. Based upon comments submitted the Agency may propose changes to its regulations and/or testing guidelines and/or labeling. We refer you to the February 20, 1991 Federal Register Notice Vol. 56, No. 34 pg. 6856 for more information in this regard.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. In case of contact immediately flush skin and eyes with plenty of water. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before smoking. If poisoning occurs, get prompt medical aid.

Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held.

In the home, cover all food handling surfaces and cover or remove all food and cooking utensils, or wash thoroughly after treatment.

Non-food areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers entries and vestibules), offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

Not for use in USDA meat and poultry plants.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried.

Physical or Chemical Hazards

FLAMMABLE. Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

Statement of Practical Treatment

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if needed.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DO NOT use in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

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General: Use this residual spray as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, waterbugs, silverfish, ticks, fleas and other insects listed below. Apply this product only as a coarse spray or crack and crevice treatment to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT:

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders, Sowbugs, Earwigs and Carpet Beetles: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets; and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters; nearby cracks and crevices; along and behind baseboards; window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. **Do Not Spray Pets With This Product.** Pets should be treated with a registered product for flea and tick control in conjunction with this treatment.

FOR CRACK AND CREVICE:

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, Brown Dog Ticks, Fleas, Earwigs and Carpet Beetles: Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream should be used in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where the above-listed insects hide.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

Flies and Mosquitoes: Use only out-of-doors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under eaves) or porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE Store in cool dry area away from heat and open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate container.
