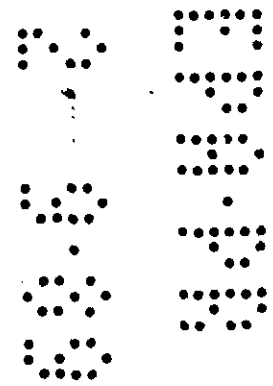

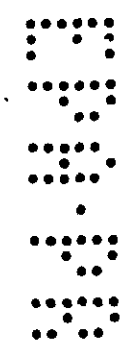
It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

To Kill Carpet Beetles: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Adult Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Place fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried, Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product before reentering treated areas.

To treat carpets, spray at the rate of one square foot per second. Repeat treatment as necessary.



STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
