Our records indicate the potential for phytotoxicity when the subject product is applied to the foliage of the more sensitive plants (i.e. ivy, philodendron, silver tree, etc.) listed on the label. Thus you should demonstrate the safety of 2X applications of this product to certain sensitive plants or appropriate precautionary language should be placed on the label prohibiting use on certain species.

This Product Kills: Aphids, Mealybugs, Whiteflies and Spider mites and provides up to four (4) weeks of control.

Spray both upper and lower leaf surfaces from a distance of 10-12 inches until visibly wet. Repeat as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
