The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. In reference to comment 2g of the Notice of Registration, add the following statement to appear after the listed plants under For Plants:

Certain indoor houseplants may be sensitive to burning of foliage or dropping of leaves.

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.

For Use on Indoor Houseplants: Such as African Violet, Dieffenbachia, Gold-Brocade Plant, Ivy, Madam Butterfly, Philodendron, Purple Passion, Schefflera and Silver Tree Plant. For plants not listed, spray one or two leaves and check for plant damage.

This Product Kills: Aphids, Mealybugs, Whiteflies and Spider mites and provides up to two (2) weeks of control.

Spray both upper and lower leaf surfaces from a distance of 10-12 inches until visibly wet. Avoid heavy wetting. Repeat as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
