Subject: Amendment - Update First Aid and Disposal Statements Unicorn House and Carpet Spray #5 EPA Registration No. 28293-192 Your submission dated April 23, 2003

Dear Ms. Varner:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below.

- 1. Under the PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS section, move the statements "Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs...until spray has dried" to the "Directions for Use" section. Delete the statements "Contains petroleum distillate. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration pneumonia hazard...In case of contact, flush with plenty of water...Obtain medical attention if irritation persists."
- 2. Revise the statement "Avoid contact with skin or eyes" to read "Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing."
- 3. Revise the statement "Do not breathe vapors or spray mist" to read "Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist."
- 4. Revise the statement "Wash with soap and warm water after use" to read "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling."
- 5. Add the following statement to the "Directions for Use" section: "Do not use in rooms/areas while occupied by patients, the elderly or the infirm. Do not apply in classrooms when in use. Do not apply to institutions (including libraries, sports facilities, etc.,) in the immediate area when occupants are present." You may delete the similar statements under precautionary statements.

- 6. Under the DIRECTIONS FOR USE section, either delete the phrases "Repeat as needed", "Repeat as necessary" or "Repeat treatment when necessary" or indicate a time period based on the residual efficacy of your product.
- 7. Under the DIRECTIONS FOR USE section, add the phrase "but not to the point of runoff" to the statement "Spray surfaces until wet."
- 8. Add the following statement to the end of the Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas section: "Also, treat yard with a product registered for yard application."
- 9. Revise the "meat and poultry plants" statement to read "Not for Use in Federally Inspected Meat and Poultry Plants."

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through skin, or inhaled. Contains petroleum distillate. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration pneumonia hazard. Do not breathe vapors or spray mist. Nonfood/feed areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries, and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

NOT FOR USE IN USDA MEAT AND POULTRY PLANTS.

General: Use this spray as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, fleas, silverfish, ticks, waterbugs, and other insects listed below. Apply this product only as a coarse spray or crack and crevice treatment to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed.

Extension Tube Use:

This product is supplied with an extension tube which is taped to one side of the can. Place extension tube into spray nozzle. When applying product, insert extension tube into cracks, crevices, holes and other openings and dispense for 2 seconds.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT:

To Kill Ants, Black Widow Spiders, Carpet Beetles, Cockroaches, Crickets, Scorpions, <u>Silverfish, Sowbugs, and Spiders</u>: Spray areas where these insects are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets; and around garbage cans, plumbing, and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, spray ant trails and around doors and windows, and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames, and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Pet's old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. DO NOT SPRAY PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT. Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product prior to reentering treated areas.

FOR CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT:

To Kill Ants, Black Widow Spiders, Brown Dog Ticks, Carpet Beetles, Cockroaches, Crickets, Fleas, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs, and Spiders: Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream should be used in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where these insects hide.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food handling surfaces.

Flies and Mosquitoes: Use only outdoors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under eaves) or porches, patios, and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.
