**To Kill Fire Ants in Their Mounds:** DO NOT DISTURB MOUND PRIOR TO TREATMENT. Attach injector rod to can and line up dot on valve cup with the injector rod to ensure complete evacuation of the can. While spraying, slowly drive rod into mound until resistance is met, which indicates the bottom of the nest has been reached. Spray for 5 seconds for each 6" diameter mound. For example, an 18" diameter mound would require three separate injections around the mound. All mounds in the vicinity should be treated. For best results treatment should be made in early morning or late evening when ants are least active.

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**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

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
