1) In the container disposal statement you must delete "Containers One gallon or Less:......Wrap and discard in trash"-not a good advice for professional applicators when using 15 gallons containers of 24% chlorpyrifos".

2) You must submit the final printed label before releasing the product to market.

Imported Fire Ant: Treatment of potted, containerized and balled and burlapped nursery stock. Use **Dursban 2E** to control imported fire ants in soil attached to roots of these plants by completely submerging the ball of soil in a tank containing **Dursban 2E** diluted at the rate of 8 fl. oz. per 100 gallons of water. Do not remove burlap wrap or plastic containers with drain holes prior to submerging. Keep soil submerged until complete saturation has occurred, normally about 30 seconds.

An alternate treatment to submerging potted plants is to apply a solution containing**Dursban 2E** (8 oz. per 100 gallons of water) as a substitute for plain water during routine watering activities. This solution should be applied to the point of run-off on a <u>twice daily</u> schedule for <u>three</u> <u>consecutive days</u>. Do not remove burlap wrap or container from plants prior to treatment. Application should be made in a well-ventilated area. <u>Treatment of Fire Ant Mounds (for use only</u> <u>in public health programs)</u>: Apply **Dursban 2E** as a drench diluted at the rate of 1 fl. oz. (30cc) per 2 gallons of water. Gently sprinkle a total of 1 gallon of the diluted solution over the surface of each mound using a sprinkler can. Thoroughly wet mound and surrounding area to a 4 ft. diameter (12 sq. ft.) For best results apply in cool weather, 65-80°F, or in early morning or late evening hours. Treat new mounds as they appear. Pressurized sprays may disturb the ants and cause migration, reducing product effectiveness.

Mosquitoes (for use in control of adult mosquitoes in public health programs only): Apply**Dursban 2E** insecticide to mosquito infested, non-crop areas according to the conditions and rates shown in the following table. Mix **Dursban 2E** with either water or oil such as kerosene or No. 2 fuel oil, using sufficient spray volume to give uniform coverage of area treated. Apply the spray using suitable application equipment such as <u>hand</u> and <u>power ground sprayers</u>, <u>mist applicators</u>, and <u>aerial spray equipment</u>.
