Dear Mr. Tharrington:

The revised labeling referenced to above, submitted in connection with the registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) as amended, is acceptable, provided you incorporate the Agency's conditions as enumerated in this letter below and submit one copy of your final printed label prior to releasing the product for shipment. If the conditions enumerated above are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA Section 6(e).

1). The Agency acknowledges the change in container size to 25 pounds as indicated on EPA form 8570-1 dated 12/14/00.

2). Please note that for fire ant control the Agency has decided that the text "for use only in Public Health Control Programs by State, Local or other Public Health Agencies and their contractors" must be replaced with "For professional use only." This text must appear on the front panel of the label and also on Page 3 of the label.

3). Because this product must be applied by some kind of equipment, you must remove the text "ready to use" on Page 2 of the draft label.

4). The text "this product is an insecticidal dust ... apply directly into cracks and crevices or other localized areas with a bulbous duster or other suitable equipment" should be placed under the section entitled "Application within non-food areas of industrial and manufacturing plants" or deleted since it clearly does not apply to the fire ant use directions.

5). You must clarify whether the instructions on Page 2 "the amount of dust to be applied will vary, but should be in the range of 1/3 to 2/3 ounces per square yard" also pertain to the indoor use in industrial and manufacturing plants.

6). We strongly recommend that you provide directions for transferring the product to the application equipment, with special emphasis on minimizing handler exposure.

7). We also strongly recommend that you add personal protective equipment (PPE) text to your label. The text should be based on the toxicity of your product and should, at the least, state something like:

Applicator and other handlers should wear: -Long sleeved shirt and long pants,

-Chemical gloves made of any waterproof material, and

-Sock plus shoes.

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(-Respiratory protection, if appropriate, may also be recommended.)

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is a ready-to-use insecticidal dust which controls pests as indicated below. Apply directly into cracks and crevices or other localized areas with a bulbous duster or other suitable equipment. The amount of dust to be applied will vary, but should usually be in the range of 1/3 to 2/3 ounces per square yard.

<u>Application within non- food areas of industrial and manufacturing plants</u>: For spot treatment only -- Apply as a light but uniform dust to localized areas where cockroaches, (including strains resistant to certain other insecticides), ants, clover mites, crickets, firebrats, silverfish and spiders are found or normally occur. For ants - apply to ant trails and wherever else these pests may find entrance.

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OUTDOOR USE

<u>IMPORTED FIRE ANT MOUND TREATMENT</u>: For use only in Public Health Control Programs by State, Local or other Public Health Agencies an their contractors.

Evenly dust two tablespoons (approximately 1 oz.) of **Unicorn Dursban 1-D Insecticide** over the top of each mound. Do not water in or disturb the mound. Apply when temperatures are between 65° and 80°F. Allow 3 to 4 days for maximum control, then repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

- **<u>STORAGE:</u>** Store in cool, dry area.
- **DISPOSAL:** Completely empty bag into application equipment. Dispose of in a sanitary landfill or incineration, or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
