Add the following under the heading Diagnosis of Ear 1. Mites:

Ear mites normally cause a dry, dark, brown, waxy, exudate with crusts in the ears of dogs and cats. The mites are easily observed by placing some of the ear exudate on a dark surface and watching carefully for white specks walking away. Do not injure the delicate tissue of the ear. Inflamed, watery, or blocked ear canals indicate a more serious condition which requires the services of a veterinarian.

2. Under Precautionary Statements add:

> For animals, discontinue use and consult veterinarian if irritation develops.

3. Under Storage and Disposal add the following:

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

The remaining information should follow the heading STORAGE.

For control of ticks, fleas and lice on dogs and cats, dilute 4 ounces of concentrate with 1 gallon of water. Dip animal into solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin.

Do not rinse. Towel dry. Repeat as necessary.

For control of ear mites: While holding pet firmly, fill each ear canal half full of solution and massage base of ear to insure that insecticidal action penetrates ear wax. Repeat treatment every other day until condition is relieved. Improvement is usually noted after two applications.
