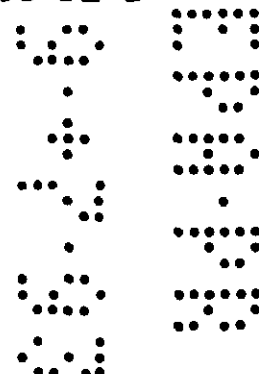

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Causes eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Avoid breathing dust. Wash thoroughly after handling. Avoid contamination of food, feed, feeding troughs and water receptacles.

Statement of Practical Treatment

If Swallowed: Give water or milk to drink and telephone for medical advice. Consult medical personnel before inducing vomiting. If medical advice cannot be obtained, then take person and product container to the nearest medical emergency treatment center or hospital.

If In Eyes: In case of eye contact, wash eyes immediately with fresh water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

Note to Physician: Carbaryl is a moderate, reversible cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal.

Environmental Hazards

This product is extremely toxic to aquatic and estuarine invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds if bees are visiting the treatment area.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ ENTIRE LABEL. USE STRICTLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH LABEL PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS AND DIRECTIONS, AND WITH APPLICABLE STATE AND FEDERAL REGULATIONS.

Apply dust at the first signs of insects. Repeat as necessary. For best results, dust in early morning or late evening when temperature is low and air is still. Apply dust so that all parts of plants are contacted, especially upper and lower leaf surfaces. May be applied up to harvest unless otherwise noted.

BEANS: Mexican Bean Beetle - 1/4 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. Leafhoppers, Bean Leaf Beetle, Cucumber Beetles, Western Bean Cutworm, Velvetbean Caterpillar, Flea Beetles, Japanese Beetle - 1/2 lb per 1,000 sq. ft. Corn Earworm, Armyworm, Tarnished Plant Bug, Stink Bugs - 3/4 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. May be applied up to harvest.

CABBAGE, BROCCOLI, BRUSSELS SPROUTS, CAULIFLOWER AND KOHLRABI: Flea Beetles, Harlequin Bug - 1/2 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. Armyworms, Imported Cabbageworm, Young Cabbage Loopers, Salt Marsh Caterpillars, Corn Earworm - 1 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. Do not apply within 3 days of harvest.

CORN: Corn Earworm (Application of this product to the tassel region of corn during the pollen shed period will seriously reduce bee populations). Corn Rootworm Adults, European Corn Borer, Fall Armyworm, Sap Beetles, Japanese Beetle, Leafhoppers, Flea Beetles - 1 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. For insects attacking silks and ears, apply at 2 to 3 day intervals starting when first silks appear and continuing until silks begin to dry. Three or more applications may be required depending on severity of infestation. May be applied up to harvest.

CUCUMBER, MELONS, PUMPKIN, SQUASH: Pickleworm, Melonworm - 1/2 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. Cucumber Beetles, Flea Beetles, Leafhoppers, Squash Bugs - 1/2 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. Avoid excessive applications. Some leaf injury may occur if treatments are made when tender foliage is wet or in the presence of prolonged high humidity. Do not use this product on watermelons in Florida. May be used up to harvest.

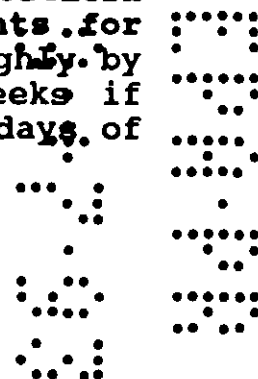
LETTUCE, CARROTS: Flea Beetles, Harlequin Bug, Leafhoppers - 1/2 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. Sixspotted Leafhopper - 3/4 lb. in a 5 to 7 day schedule. Armyworms, Cabbage Caterpillars, Corn Earworm, Spittlebugs, Tarnished Plant Bugs, Lygus Bugs, Stink Bugs - 1 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. For best results in the control of Corn Earworm after lettuce heads begin to form use 1 lb. in a 5 to 7 day schedule. May be used up to harvest on carrots. Do not use on head lettuce within 3 days of harvest and to leaf lettuce within 14 days.

EGGPLANT, PEPPERS: Colorado Potato Beetles, Flea Beetles - 1/2 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. Tomato Fruitworm, Tomato Hornworm, European Corn Borer, Lace Bugs - 1 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft.

STRAWBERRIES: Meadow Spittlebug, Strawberry Leafroller, Strawberry Weevil - 1 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. Do not apply within 1 day of harvest.

TOMATO: Flea Beetles, Leafhoppers, Tomato Fruitworm, Fall Armyworm, Tomato Hornworm, European Corn Borer - 1 1/2 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.

POULTRY: (Chickens, Partridges, Pheasants, Pigeons): Northern Fowl Mite, Lice and as a supplement to premise treatments for Chicken Mite, Fleas - 1 lb. per 100 birds. Apply thoroughly by means of a shaker can or hand duster. Repeat in 4 weeks if necessary. Do not use on Poultry or game birds within 7 days of slaughter.



IN OR AROUND POULTRY HOUSES: Chicken Mite, Fleas, Bed Bugs - 1 lb. per 40 sq. ft. of litter or floor space and to roosts and adjacent areas by means of a shaker can, hand duster or power duster. Force dust into cracks and crevices. Repeat as necessary. Do not treat nest litter. Avoid direct contamination of eggs. Do not use in premise treatment within 7 days of slaughter.

DOGS, CATS: Ticks, Fleas - Dust lightly over the animal and rub thoroughly into the skin. Apply also to the feet between the toes and on the legs. Apply at weekly intervals if needed. Avoid treatment of kittens and puppies under 4 weeks of age. **NOTE:** Do not allow treated pets back on carpet or rugs in the house as this product may stain or discolor rugs and wall-to-wall carpets. Dust lightly in and around kennels and dog houses by means of a shaker can, hand or power duster. Force dust into cracks and crevices. Repeat as necessary, but not more often than once weekly. **DO NOT USE ON PREGNANT DOGS.**

DO NOT USE IN THE HOME: DO NOT APPLY TO RUGS AND CARPETS, AS STAINING MAY OCCUR.

Do not apply under conditions involving possible drift to food, forage or other plantings that might be damaged or the crops thereof rendered unfit for sale, use or consumption.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put concentrate or dilute into food or drink containers. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Store in a cool, dry place, preferably in a locked storage area.

DISPOSAL: Product - Partially filled bag may be disposed of by securely wrapping original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Container - Do not reuse bag. Discard bag in trash.
