PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if inhaled. Causes moderate eye injury. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist and contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. **Do not use on horses.**

Environmental Hazards

This product is highly toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

Physical & Chemical Hazards

Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

Statement of Practical Treatment

IF SWALLOWED: Promptly drink a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting unless under a physician's care. This product contains petroleum distillate. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air, apply artificial respiration if indicated. Get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply to Dairy Cattle (lactating and non-lactating) and Beef Cattle.

APPLICATION: For up to 6 weeks' control of susceptible horn flies, apply over shoulders and down midline of back.

For control of lice and aid in control of face flies, stable flies, horse flies, deer flies, house flies, mosquitoes, and black flies, apply from poll down neck, over shoulders.

DOSE: 1/8 fl. oz. (3.75 ml) per 250 lbs. body wt. to maximum of 1/2 fl. oz. (15 ml) per animal. (1 ml = 1 cc). Repeat treatment as needed, but not more often than once every 2 weeks. For optimum lice control, two treatments at a 14 day interval are recommended. **DO NOT USE ON HORSES.**

SPECIAL NOTE: This product is non-systemic and will not control grubs.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage and Spill Procedures: Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperatures. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, earth, fuller's earth, etc. Dispose of with chemical waste.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of at or by an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal: Do not reuse container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
