
The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. Add the statement "Do not puncture or incinerate!" at the beginning of the Disposal instructions in accordance with the guidance in PR Notice 2001-6 for products in pressurized containers.
2. Correct the following typographical errors:
 - Delete the bracket ("] ") after "Tetramethrin" in the ingredient statement.
 - Change "suckling insects" to "sucking insects" at the bottom of page 2.
3. On page 4, "Ruebella" is listed under "DO NOT USE ON:". We are not aware of a plant with this name. Please confirm that this is the plant you intended to list and correct the name if it is not what you intended.

STORAGE: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

PLEASANT SCENT. Begins killing instantly. With a combination of ingredients, Strong enough to kill a broad range of bugs yet can be used on house or ornamental plants. Kills fourteen common household bugs. Kills household bugs, kills garden bugs, kills suckling insects, kills leaf eating insects, kills chewing insects. When used as directed, won't harm

zinnias, geraniums, even roses. (SEE BELOW FOR A COMPLETE LIST OF PLANTS).

**Shake well before using.
Hold container upright while spraying.
Spray away from self and other persons.**

In the home all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before reuse. **REMOVE** pets and tightly cover fish bowls and aquariums in areas being sprayed. **BEFORE USING** near appliances with pilot lights, be sure to extinguish pilot lights. **TURN OFF** electrical equipment in area being treated. **DO NOT** smoke while using.

TO KILL HOUSEHOLD INSECTS: TO KILL: HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES, SMALL FLYING MOTHS, GNATS AND OTHER FLYING INSECTS. Close doors and windows in area to be sprayed. Point nozzle upward. Direct spray to all parts of area to be treated, especially light sources such as windows. Spray for 5 - 10 seconds for each 1000 cubic feet. Vacate room. Keep room closed for 1 hour after spraying. Ventilate area before reoccupying.

TO KILL: WASPS, MUD DAUBERS, PAPER NEST WASPS. Spray into nests and hiding places at dusk when these insects are at rest. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL: ROACHES, WATERBUGS, SPIDERS, CRICKETS, CARPET BEETLES AND OTHER CRAWLING INSECTS. USE AS A SPOT SPRAY ONLY. Hold sprayer about 12 inches from the surface being sprayed. Spray thoroughly into hiding areas such as cracks, crevices, baseboards, damp areas and other places where insects may hide. Spray directly on insects if possible.

TO KILL: ANTS. Spray around door and window frames. Thoroughly treat trails, runs, walks and other places where insects may be seen.

KILLS INSECTS ON ORNAMENTAL PLANTS. TO KILL: APHIDS, LEAF HOPPERS, LACE BUGS, SPIDER MITES, FALL ARMYWORMS, CUTWORMS, WHITE FLIES, CHINCH BUGS, TENT CATERPILLARS, GYPSY MOTH, BAGWORMS AND OTHER ORNAMENTAL PLANT INSECTS: Spray ornamental plants when air is still, the dew is gone and the temperature is not above 90°F. Use with caution on young plants, new growth and tender foliage. Spray with a slow, sweeping motion. Avoid wetting. Spray about 36 inches from plants. Repeat application as long as insects are present.
