The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Permethrin and Tetramethrin Interim Decisions, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. General Precautions and Restrictions

Entry restrictions: Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried.

Application restrictions: Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets, either directly or through drift. Do not apply to pets. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not apply if food is present. Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application. Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment and food preparation surfaces, or wash them before use. All outdoor applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatment only. Spot treatments must not exceed two square feet in size (for example, 2ft. by 1 ft or 4 ft. by 0.5 ft.). Do not apply when the wind speed is greater than 15 mph. Do not make application during rain. Avoid making applications when rainfall is expected before the product has sufficient time to dry (minimum 4 hours) Rainfall within 24 hours after application may cause unintended runoff of pesticide application Do not water treated area to point of run-off. Treat surfaces to ensure thorough coverage but avoid runoff. Not for broadcast use on indoor residential surfaces. Do not use in commercial food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other sites where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not allow to enter indoor or outdoor drains.

Do not spray vegetation directly to prevent damage to foliage. If spray accidentally contacts foliage, immediately wash with water. Test product in an inconspicuous area before applying.

Do not spray the product into fish pools, ponds, streams, or lakes. Do not apply directly to impervious horizontal surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, and patios except as a spot or crack-and-crevice treatment. To treat insects harbored in voids and cracks-and-crevices, applications must be made in such a manner to limit dripping and avoid runoff onto untreated structural surfaces and plants.

For best results, spray in early morning or late evening when activity is minimal. Stand a safe distance from nest and not directly underneath. (Remove protective cap.) Hold can upright and point spray opening toward nest with wind at your back. Spray until nest is thoroughly saturated to kill the entire nest population. Residual action will kill wasps and hornets returning to the nest. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest.

To kill wasps, hornets and yellow jackets under eaves, screens, window frames, doors, patios, cracks, holes or crevices whenever insects are noticed, spray for about 1-2 seconds or until surfaces are moist. To prevent entrance of insects into the house, spray around points where

insects enter such as outside plumbing, faucets, etc., and cracks or crevices in foundation as well as along sills and ledges.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Do not store near heat or open flame. Store in cool dry area away from children and pets and away from heat, sparks and open flame. Do not transport or store below 32°F.

DISPOSAL: Do not Puncture or Incinerate!

If empty – Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled** – Do not pour or dispose down-the-drain or sewer. Call your local solid waste Agency for local disposal options.
