DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

<u>Diagnosis of Ear Mites:</u> Ear mites normally cause a dry, dark, brown, waxy exudate with crusts in the ears of dogs, cats and rabbits. The mites are easily observed by placing some of the ear exudate on a dark surface and watching carefully for white specks walking away. Do not injure the delicate tissue of the ear. Inflamed, watery, or blocked ear canals indicate a more serious condition which requires the services of a veterinarian.

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EPA EST. NO. 62478-FL-1A 44616-MO-1B Subscript used is first letter of run code on container. For control of ear mites: While holding pet firmly, fill each ear canal half full of solution and massage base of ear to insure that insecticidal action penetrates ear wax. Repeat treatment every other day until condition is relieved. Improvement is usually noted after two applications.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store only in original container, in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
