FIRST AID: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg white, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a Physician immediately.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

For general cleaning and disinfecting in hospitals, schools, and related institutions, use 1:256 solution. One stroke of the pump (1/2 oz.) provides correct amount of ASEPTIPHENE per gallon of water. Wet surface thoroughly by wiping, mopping or scrubbing, depending on condition of area to be disinfected and cleaned. Removal of gross filth or heavy soil deposits is recommended prior to application of ASEPTIPHENE. Treated food contact surfaces must be thoroughly scrubbed with detergents and rinsed with potable water prior to re-use.

ASEPTIPHENE is safe to use on: resilient (linoleum, vinyl, asphalt, rubber) floors; sealed wood and composition floors; conductive floors; terrazzo, marble, ceramic tile, cement, painted metals, stainless steel, glass, plastic, nylon, and fabric surfaces.

DANGER: Keep Out of Reach of Children. Corrosive. Causes eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and wear rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
