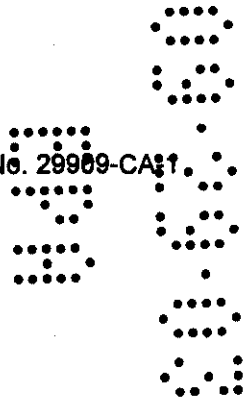

Wet the pet and apply a generous amount of shampoo, working it well into the coat. For the best results, the pet should be left in a lathered state for four to five minutes before rinsing with warm water. Do not reapply product for 2 weeks.

[Alternate Language for Horses]

Horses: Controls stable flies, horse flies, deer flies, face flies, gnats and mosquitoes. Remove excess dirt and dust by brushing coat. Follow above procedure. Do not apply shampoo around eyes. Do not repeat treatment for 7 days. Not for use on horses to be used for food.

Storage: Avoid contamination of feed or foodstuffs.
