1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:
 - a. Add the phrase, "EPA Registration No. 29909-34."
 - b. Update the Environmental Hazards by changing "By cleaning of equipment and disposal of wastes" to "when disposing of equipment washwaters."
 - c. Change the Pesticide Disposal statement to read "Wastes resulting from the use of this pesticide may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility."
 - d. Add an address or P. O. Box Number to your company name on the label.

e. The word "Wipe-Out" in the product name is too promising and should be deleted. False or misleading statements concerning the effectiveness of the product are not allowed.

f. Although ready-to-use, it is not apparent that the product is sprayed directly from the original container. We discourage indoor use of pesticides by the lay person unless it is ready to be applied as marketed (as in a pump spray or aerosol formulation). This prevents the potential exposure to children and pets from ingesting/contacting the pesticide in containers such as coffee cans (for paint brush application) and Windex or other similar bottles which are commonly used by homeowners.

Allowing the homeowner to use containers other than the product container to apply the pesticide defeats the purpose of label instructions, precautions, and first aid treatment, since the information would not be readily available for use should exposure occur.

If the product does require transfer to a separate container add "Recommended For Commercial/Industrial Use."

g. Under Precautionary Statements add "Do not use on old, sick or debilitated animals. Do not use on nursing puppies or puppies under 3 months of age."

h. Qualify the site Premises on front and back panels with the descriptor household (i.e. household premises).

3. The storage stability data are acceptable, however, the one year analysis for pyrethrin is on the threshold and may drop below the label claim. You may want to add slight excess pyrenone to compensate for the storage stability loss.

4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

TO CONTROL FLEAS AND TICKS ON DOGS (FOR 14 DAYS):

Applied as a spray: Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure that the animal's entire body is treated, including the legs and underbody. Fluff the hair while spraying so that the spray will penetrate to the skin and thoroughly wet it. Do not spray into eyes or face. Avoid contact with genitalia.

Applied as a dip: Wet the dog with water before treatment. Sponge or pour WIPE OUT on the dog until its fur and skin are thoroughly wet, making sure that the animal's entire body is treated, including the legs and underbody. Do not treat the dog's face. Avoid contact with genitalia.

TO CONTROL FLEAS AND TICKS ON PREMISES:

Apply as a direct spray to control accessible stages of fleas and ticks. Spray to lightly dampen absorbent surfaces or to the point of runoff on nonabsorbent surfaces. Thoroughly spray infested areas, pet beds and resting quarters, cracks and crevices, along baseboards, moldings and window and door frames as well as localized areas of floor and floor covering. Repeat as necessary.

TO CONTROL CRAWLING INSECTS:

Apply as a direct spray to control accessible stages of crawling insects including, but not limited to, cockroaches, ants, fleas, ticks, spiders, silverfish and crickets. Spray to thoroughly wet exposed insects. Direct spray into hiding places, cracks and crevices, along baseboards and around door and window frames.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

CONTAINERS LARGER THAN ONE GALLON:

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE AND SPILL PROCEDURES : Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperatures. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, earth, fuller's earth, etc. Dispose of with chemical waste.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: water that cannot be used should be disposed of at or by a sanitary landfill.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: offer for recycling or reuse or in a sanitary landfill in accordance with local procedures.

CONTAINERS ONE GALLON OR LESS:

STORAGE : Store in a cool, dry place, inaccessible to children.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse containers. Dispose of in layers of newspaper and in a sanitary landfill.

PRECAUTIONS FOR HUMANS

Harmful if swallowed. Irritating if inhaled. Causes irritation if on skin or clothing. Avoid breathing vapors. Wash with soap and water after use. Remove pets and birds before use. **USE ON CATS.**

STATEMENT
