Harvested seed are not allowed for sale as commercial seed in the U.S. under the current conditions of this registration but any grain containing 59122xMON810 may be handled in accordance with legal and regulatory requirements (non-treated seed can be sold as grain).
4. This plant-incorporated protectant may be combined through conventional breeding with other registered plant-incorporated protectants that are similarly approved for use in combination, through conventional breeding with other registered plant-incorporated protectants to produce inbred corn lines and hybrid corn varieties with combined pesticidal traits.
5. This approval does not affect any terms or conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing terms or conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with it.


