

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing.

FIRST AID: If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds. Permits may be required for discharges containing this pesticide into lakes, streams, ponds or public water. For guidance, contact the regional office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Keep container closed when not in use. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse (or equivalent) and dispose of container in an incinerator or in an approved landfill, or bury in a safe place. Rinsate that cannot be used or reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies. Open dumping is prohibited.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

ALGAE GO is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools. For maximum effectiveness, pools containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using **ALGAE GO**.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 75 to 115 fluid ounces of **ALGAE GO** per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning.

For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 41 to 75 fluid ounces of **ALGAE GO** per 10,000 gallons of water.

To maintain pools free of visible algae growth, subsequent additions of 13.5 to 27 fluid ounces of **ALGAE GO** per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after the initial treatment.

ALGAE GO is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and effective at both acid and alkaline pH. **ALGAE GO** can be used in pools treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix **ALGAE GO** with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.
