# General: Prior to sanitation or disinfection, clean all surfaces with a suitable detergent and rinse thoroughly with potable water. Follow the recommendation of your local Health Department regarding sanitation and disinfection of surfaces.

Disinfection Solution: In hospitals, public rooms, and homes clean all surfaces with detergent and rinse them thoroughly. Wipe, mop or scrub equipment, floors, walls and woodwork thoroughly using 3½ ounces to 5 gallons of water. This solution will be effective against Pseudomonas aeruginosa PRD-10.

Sanitation of Meat Packing and Food Processing Equipment: Clean and rinse equipment thoroughly, then apply sanitizing solution of 1 oz. per 4 gallons of water. Rinse thoroughly.

Sanitation of Dairy Equipment: Clean and rinse equipment thoroughly, then apply sanitizing solution of 1 oz. per 4 gallons of water. Rinse thoroughly.

Restaurants and Bar Rinse: Dishes, glassware, silverware, cooking utensils, wash with soap or synthetic detergent, inse thoroughly and then immerse in a solution containing 1 oz. to 4 gallons of water (195 ppm).

Sanitation of Beauty Parlor and Barber Shop Equipment: Wash thoroughly in soap and rinse. Soak combs, brushes, and razors for 10 minutes in solution of 1 oz. concentrate per gallon of water.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard.
