It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a m

in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and hot tubs that do not contain fish. For maximum effectiveness use in decorative fountains, and ponds containing heavy growth of algae to using ALGI-KILL.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of ALGI-KILL to remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of pools add initially 7 to 14 fluid ounces of ALGI-KILL per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of ALGI-KILL per 10,000 gallons of water should be made 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds with algae growth require an initial dose of 1.2 to 1.4 fluid ounces of ALGI-KILL per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of ALGI-KILL should be made for maintenance.

ALGI-KILL will control algae during the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. Only treated during the swimming season and are not in use. Add 12 fluid ounces of algacide per 10,000 gallons of water. If season pools have some visible algae growth, add ALGI-KILL per 10,000 gallons. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of water and the pool be made for maximum effectiveness. It is necessary to repeat the treatment one or more times.

ALGI-KILL is recommended to treat pools and spas and is effective against algae. ALGI-KILL can be used in conjunction with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of chlorine required. However, do not mix ALGI-KILL with other chlorine products.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed. Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking container should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children. DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container.
