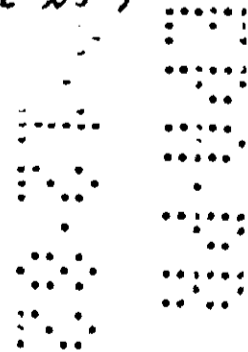

READ INSTRUCTIONS

Use of Ring 5 Flea Tick Fogger is an effective way to kill and control fleas, ticks, mosquitos, houseflies and cockroaches when used as directed. To reduce or eliminate future problems, all animals should be treated weekly with Ring 5 Super Flea Flea/Tick Spray or Ring 5 Flea/Tick Spray. Ring 5 Flea/Tick Fogger has no objectionable odor; it will not stain or leave an oily residue.

DIRECTIONS: Cover exposed food, dishes and food handling equipment. Open doors and cabinets of area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Close outside doors and windows. Put out all open flames and pilot lights. Use one unit for each 5,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry. Remove old pet bedding and wash in hot water or destroy. Place several layers of newspaper under fogger.

TO OPERATE VALVE: Point away from face and eyes when releasing. Press valve button all the way down, hooking the catch to lock open. Place fogger on stand or table in the center of area to be treated. Leave building at once and keep closed for four hours. Open all doors and windows for 30 minutes to air out. For severe problems, a second treatment should be given in 5 to 7 days.
